

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM ELECTION
ST. CROIX COUNTY, WISCONSIN
April 3, 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in St. Croix County in the State of Wisconsin, on Tuesday, April 3, 2018, the following question will be submitted to a vote of the people pursuant to law:

QUESTION 1: “Shall the County of St. Croix adopt the following resolution?”

RESOLVED, that “We the People” of the County of St. Croix, Wisconsin, seek to reclaim democracy from the expansion of corporate personhood rights and the corrupting influence of unregulated political contributions and spending. We stand with communities across the country to support passage of an amendment to the United States Constitution stating:

1. Only human beings are endowed with constitutional rights – not corporations, unions, nonprofits or other artificial entities, and
2. Money is not speech, and therefore regulating political contributions and spending is not equivalent to limiting speech.”

This referendum is a result of Resolution 51(2017) adopted by the St. Croix County Board of Supervisors on November 7, 2017, a copy of which can be viewed or downloaded from the St. Croix County website at www.sccwi.gov. A copy also can be obtained from the office of the St. Croix County Clerk at 1101 Carmichael Road, Hudson, WI 54016.

Acceptable Photo ID will be required to vote at this election. If you do not have a photo ID you may obtain a free ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.
