General Instructions

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and complete the arrow next to the name like this

Presidential Preference Vote

In the Presidential Preference Vote:

- You may vote in only ONE party's primary.
- · You may vote only ONCE.
- If you vote more than once, your choices will not be counted.

Special Instructions for Presidential Preference Vote

Choose the party in which you will vote. Within the party you have chosen, you have ONE of 3 choices:

- Vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot in the party you have chosen.
- Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen.
- Write in the name of another person to become the presidential candidate of the party you have chosen.
